## Memory Lane

The group of men who captured minor titles for Aghabullogue in the 1940's and junior titles in 1952 1954 & 1955 played some tremendous hurling. Their level of skill was fantastic, their commitment to the sport of hurling was immense. Remember these titles were won during some of the most economically difficult years in the countries history. Great sacrifices were made not only to attend games but to even go training.

Everyone from that era who were lucky enough to have seen these men play speak about the game that was played in Coachford between Aghabullogue and a London – Irish selection which was touring the country in 1955. Everyone says that **this game was one of the best if not the best game ever played in Coachford.**

The people tell of how in 1952 a huge crowd turned up to see Aghabullogue play Donoughmore in the final. Others talk about the exceptional competition that the junior hurling championship in Muskerry was at that time, how teams like Cloughduv ,Donoughmore , Blarney & Inniscarra were brilliant but **Aghabullogue were remarkable.**

These teams were exceptional because of the players. These teams were exceptional because of the commitment given by the men involved and the love they showed for not only playing hurling but playing the game at its best.

The players that played on the 1952 54 & 55 teams ensured that Aghabullogue Hurling was held in high esteem for over a decade when these hurlers played minor and junior for our parish.

These men were not just hurlers to the people of Aghabullogue at the time. No they were **heroes** and remained **heroes** of our parish for the generations that came after them.
